A suggestion from a relative changed Laura Isela Rodriguez's life.


Rodriguez owns and is the creative brain behind Laura's CakePop Shop, a Kansas City, Kansas-based business. She started the business in February 2019. The shop has developed a following for its cake pops, which she describes as “edible art on a stick.”

Rodriguez—a native of Camargo, Chihuahua, Mexico, who has lived in Kansas City, Kansas, for several years—got the idea for selling cake pops after making pirate-themed cake pops for her son’s birthday.

“My husband’s aunt, Arabel, told me I should sell cake pops,” she said. “She’s the one who planted the idea in my head.”

In addition to cake pops, Rodriguez offers various chocolate-covered treats, including strawberries, marshmallows, pretzels, Oreos, cakesicles and Rice Krispy treats. She also sells churro cheesecake, and on occasion, cookies. However, her cake pops are the stars of her menu, she said.
